Greetings!

Hope you all have had a safe and quality time with your family and friends. This circular is to brief you about the protocols to be followed with respect to the re- opening of the school. We expect your whole hearted support towards fulfilling the same.



Support your child to join the school:

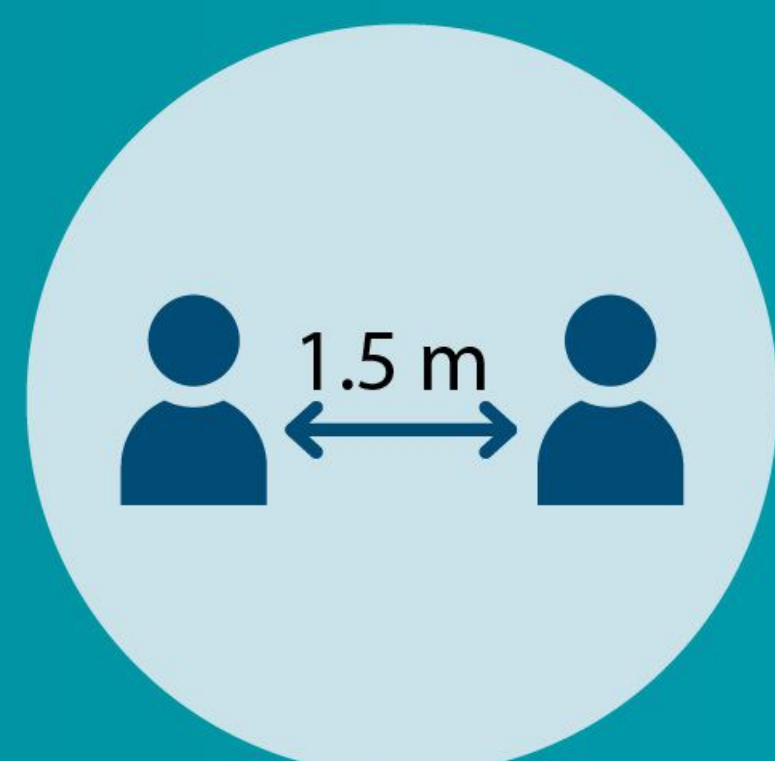
- Speak to your child about COVID -19 and help them to be resilient.
- Continuously check with the well- being of your child when the school begins.
- Have an open conversation with your ward about returning to school.
- Reassure them about the safety measures and precautions the school will have for their protection.
- Make them aware of the necessity of wearing the mask, maintaining safe distance, sanitizing hands and being hygienic.

At the beginning of the term:

- Review the mode of learning your child is adopting [whether online / onsite].
- If you have travelled outside the country, you have to submit the COVID – 19 PCR test result on the joining day itself.
- It is mandatory for you to download the Al Hosn App to ensure the traceability in the event of infection.
- Do ensure that your child does not have a fever or any symptoms such as cough, breathing difficulty or body aches.
- Please ensure that your ward has at least two masks to wear at school during the day.

Entry and Exit:

- No parents are allowed inside the school premises.
- If in case you need to come to school, please make sure you wear the mask and maintain the safe distancing of 1.5 m.
- Non- contact temperature screening will take place at the entrance of the school.



Health and Safety Measures:

- Classrooms will be arranged in accordance with the social distancing of 1.5m.
- Advise your child to be in their assigned seats and maintain the safe distance and showcase responsible behavior.
- It is advisable to send the necessary stationery with your child as sharing of the stationery is not allowed in the school.
- It would be highly appreciated if you can provide well packed homely food for your child.
- Physical education at school remain suspended until further notice. Instead virtual activities will be conducted.
- The school has staggered break times to avoid gathering among the students.
- Please ensure that you don't send any partying items for celebrating birthdays in school as such gathering and sharing of food is strictly prohibited inside the school premises.
- If your child suffers from any health issues, we are ready to offer 100% on line learning. But, if you are opting On- Site learning, it is mandatory to submit the medical certificate to the school clinic.

If your child becomes sick at school:

- If your child begins to show symptoms of COVID - 19, he/ she will immediately be quarantined to the isolation room and will be monitored by a school nurse.
- You will be intimated at the earliest to retrieve your child from the school.
- Be rest assured that the school shall not administer any medicines to your child.
- If your child tests positive for COVID- 19, you are mandated to inform the school so that the school can take measures to secure the health of the rest of the school community. Your child's medical report will not be shared with anyone.
- The child should not return to school until the PCR result is negative.

Transportation:

- The buses will operate with 50% capacity and advise your child to be on the seats assigned to them.
- Sage distancing of 1.5 meters should be maintained while on the bus.
- Temperature will be taken prior to students boarding the buses. Please note that the children with elevated body temperature will not be allowed on the bus. Hence it is mandatory for you to wait until the bus departs.
