Weekly plan 3rd week of November: 13.11.2023 to 16.11.2023

Communication and Language

This week, students will expand their vocabulary with new words like flat, apartment, villa, tent, and studio apartment. They'll engage in discussions about the various types of homes found in their local area. They'll explore the materials used to construct houses and what makes a good house through pictures and videos shown by the teacher. Additionally, they'll talk about different houses they've seen in various countries and name some of the homes they have seen in the UAE. It's a week of language enrichment and learning about different homes worldwide.

Literacy

This week's focus is on the letters "Bb" and "Jj." The vocabulary words include rabbit, bib, crab, bat, bag, big, cub, jellyfish, jam, jump, jog, and jet. To enhance learning, students will engage in various activities such as using blocks to create a home and drawing their own homes, labelling features like doors and windows. They'll also practice the names, sounds, and vocabulary of the letters, along with reading words from the "a" family. It's a week filled with letter exploration and language development.

Letters for the week : 'Bb' - 'Jj'

New Vocabulary for this week:

Expressive Art and Design

This week, students will get creative by building houses with different materials. They'll find inspiration in pictures of various house types and have fun with modelling, using materials like clay, building blocks, and more to craft their own houses. To enhance their understanding of the topic, parents can take a walk with their child to explore the different types of houses in their neighbourhood. It's a week filled with hands-on creativity and discovery!

Mathematics

حرف الراء(ر): يتعرف الطلاب إلى حرف الراء اسماً وصوتاً وشكلاً من خلال البوربوينت والصور والكلمات وسوف يكتسبون كلمات جديدة على مدار الأسبوع ، ويشارك الطلاب في الحوار والمناقشة لتنمية مهارة الاستماع والتحدث لديهم خاصة عند الاستماع إلى قصة الحرف وربطها بالواقع، وتسمية مفردات الحرف.

يميز الطلاب الحرف مع أصواته القصيرة الثلاث (الفتحة والضمة والكسرة) من خلال الصور والكلمات وممارسة الأنشطة التعليمية المختلفة مثل مطابقة الصور ومطابقة الحرف بالصور التي تبدأ به بهدف تعزيز مهارة اللغة والقراءة، والتحدث بين الطلاب لغرس روح المنافسة بينهم ، وكتابة الحرف بالشكل الصحيح مع تعزيز قدراتهم الإبداعية.
