


# **ROSARY PRIVATE SCHOOL – MUWEILAH, SHARJAH** FOUNDATION STAGE 2

#### **Communication and Language**

This week, our students will embark on an exciting journey to explore the world of dinosaurs and fossils. They will encounter words like "dinosaur," "fossil," "huge," "long," "sharp," "egg," and "history." We'll delve into the fascinating realm of these ancient creatures and ponder the noises they might have made. They will discuss museum visits and the remarkable things one can see there. It's a week of discovery and learning about the captivating world of dinosaurs!

#### Personal, Social, Emotional

This week, our students will talk about what dinosaurs liked to eat, wondering if they were plant-eaters. The children will play pretend detectives and imagine where they might discover dinosaur bones. They'll let their imaginations run wild as they think about meeting a real dinosaur. They will also discuss when dinosaurs disappeared. It's a week full of curiosity and adventures in the world of ancient creatures!

#### **Literacy**

This week, our children will dive into learning with a focus on the letters 'Ll' and 'Ff', as well as revising the sight words they have learnt. They'll also embark on an exploration of the concepts of right and left. Reading about dinosaurs, they'll identify various types of these ancient creatures from the story. Creative activities include crafting dinosaur footprints and writing their friends' names. They'll match pictures with words, retell the story in their own words, sequence the story using pictures, and engage in the fun challenge of finding opposites. It's a week packed with interactive and educational experiences!

#### **Expressive Art and Design**

This week, children will get creative with various hands-on activities. They'll use Playdough to sculpt their very own dinosaurs and paint with brushes to create dinosaur footprints. Exploring different pasta shapes, they'll craft dinosaurs complete with spikes and teeth. Their imaginations will run wild as they draw scenes from the story's setting, and they'll also have an exciting time searching for fossils in the sandbox area. It's a week filled with artistic and imaginative adventures!

### **Understanding the World**

This week, our students will dive into the world of dinosaurs, where they'll learn to **recognize** and name common dinosaur species. They'll closely observe and **describe the unique** characteristics of these prehistoric creatures and start to grasp when and where dinosaurs **lived.** Through engaging resources like pictures, models, and books, they'll meet various dinosaur species such as Tyrannosaurus rex, Triceratops, and Brachiosaurus. Together, we'll explore questions like whether they've ever seen a dinosaur or know the names of any. They'll describe what makes each dinosaur special, guess their sizes, and ponder where dinosaurs lived and what they ate. And of course, we'll delve into the mystery of why there are no dinosaurs around today. It's a week of thrilling discoveries and dinosaur adventures!

## **Mathematics**

This week, children will continue their numerical journey, getting to know numbers 13 and 14 and expanding their counting skills from 1 to 20. They will also be introduced to the concept of place value. Engaging activities will include drawing 14 dinosaurs and counting the spikes and teeth on each one. They'll explore size and weight, determining which dinosaurs were larger and heavier. Additionally, they'll engage in a fun challenge to count the footprints in a picture and find out how tall the biggest dinosaur was. It's a week of mathematical exploration and discovery! Number for the week: 13 and 14 **Counting numbers: 1-20** Understanding the concept of Place Value **3-D shapes (cube and cylinder)** 

### **Physical Development**

This week, we have some exciting activities planned. Children will have the opportunity to become little archaeologist by searching for toy dinosaur bones buried in a sand tray. They can also join a circle and use their imaginations to move like dinosaurs, exploring the differences between large, heavy ones and small, light ones. To make it even more engaging, parents can take their kids to Dubai Mall, where they can play detective and search for a real dinosaur skeleton. It's a week of hands-on exploration and imaginative adventures!
